The Friends of Pope Farm Conservancy is excited to welcome Dr. Amy Rosebrough, archeologist at the Wisconsin State Historical Society, for a special virtual talk on Tuesday, January 24, 2023, at 6:30 p.m. about the recent discoveries of two ancient canoes in Lake Mendota. These remarkably well-preserved wooden vessels were probably made by the Effigy Moundbuilders, ancestors of the modern Ho-Chunk Nation. Amy will provide a current update on the preservation process and answer any questions you may have.
